The Compliance Advisory Panel is an open forum through which members speak freely and openly about environmental quality matters. The CAP meets approximately 2-4 times a year. The public comment portion of each meeting provides an opportunity for small business owners, operators and managers to bring issues of concern directly to the attention of CAP members.
