Consideration of approval of a Community Development Block Grant- CARES Act Coronavirus Relief (CDBG-CV) Grant Agreement (1137-25-951-CV-01) in an amount not to exceed sixteen million four thousand one hundred dollars (\$16,004,100.00) to Mississippi Children's Home Society dba Canopy Children's Solutions to install the Canopy Anywhere technology-driven mental healthcare platform into public school districts throughout Mississippi.

  - 6. Consideration and approval of the Amended and Restated Air Service Agreement (ASG-08) between the Mississippi Development Authority and

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Breeze Aviation Group, Inc., Utah, pursuant to the Air Service Growth Program in the amount not to exceed one million four hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$1,470,000).

Consideration and approval of a grant agreement between Mississippi State University and the Mississippi Development Authority, Energy and Natural Resources Division, in an amount not to exceed one million one hundred eighty-eight thousand two hundred twenty-three dollars (\$1,188,223.00) to establish State-Based Collaborative partners to expand the decision-making capacity and expertise of local Mississippi leaders and local governments regarding reliable and renewable energy siting and permitting activities.
