## 3. Water Pollution Control Revolving Loan Fund (WPCRLF) Program Loan Interest Rate Reduction and Subsidy Eligibility Threshold Adjustment

The staff will brief the Commission on a planned reduction of the WPCRLF loan interest rates and adjustment of the subsidy eligibility thresholds for projects awarded in fiscal years FY-19, FY-20, and FY-21. These adjustments are intended 1) to help ease the economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on communities needing to proceed with wastewater infrastructure projects, 2) to stimulate demand for WPCRLF loans due to the currently significant funds availability, and 3) to ensure that WPCRLF interest rates stay "below market rate" as required by federal and state law.
